It is hard to believe that I have completed three months of Kiva Events already. When I was first approached about joining the TWC Board, I felt my biggest obstacle was I didn't know enough of the members in our club. In order for me to be successful I would have to put myself out there, meet new members and listen to what they wanted from their club. I have met a lot of wonderful new friends in just a short time. I am very grateful to all of you!

Since the beginning of 2023 I changed the ticket purchasing process from buying a table of ten to limiting tickets to 4 per member. We negotiated with the Kiva Lifestyle Team to open up the event to more members. At our March event we had 138 members attend, the highest attendance ever. We can sell up to 160 tickets for the monthly events up from 120 previously. Our partners from RNDC have reintroduced education into the presentation and have allowed some Q&AS. We are elevating the food pairings, and offering a few larger portions for each month. Each month we work with Michael and Tim from RNDC to get the best possible price for the wines and try to offer something unique. In the past three months we sold just under 600 bottles of wine. The feedback from our members has been very positive and encouraging. With the information from the survey we hope to continue to evolve our monthly events and our holiday party. Thanks to all 187 members that took the time to complete the survey.

We have an exciting April lineup of wines from the Central Coast. Each month we not only have board members at the pre-taste we invite members to help choose the wines.

I honestly have to say this was one of the most fun we had choosing the wines. There was a lot of lively communication back and forth until we chose the 6 wines that will be presented on April 30th.

Until then keep the emails coming good or bad we want to hear from our members.
